I have the honor to report that on November 18, 1944 Ceneral Giuseppe Castellano, together with Maffia leaders including Calogero Vizzini conferred with Virgilio Nasi, head of the well-known hasi family in Trapani and asked him to take over the leadership of a Maffia-backed movement for Sicilian autonomy which will have the cooperation of the FDCS and the Legge Agricultura.

This movement has not yet matured to the point where a full report can be made and the following information is based on such hata as have come to hand; but it is reliable.

General Gastellano, who is a Sibilian, took command of the re-activated Aosta Division in the beginning of October and Since that time has been very active in studying the Sicilian problem and looking for a solution. He has developed close contacts with the Maffia leaders and has met them on frequent cacasions.

As reported in my despetch No. 375 dated November 13, 1944, prominent members of the Maffia met in Palermo and one of the results of this conference was the decificion to ask Virgilio Masi of Trapani to head up this imprement with the ultimate intention of his becoming thigh Commissioner. The Masi family have been well known in the Province of Trapani for at least two genferations and are highly respected by all classes. It is understood that Masi is a Labor Democrat but he has played little part in the political upheavals on the island throughout the past year.

During the next few weeks an active compaign will get underway to gain more adherents to the movement. The FDOS, which as already reported is very strong, will, of course, cooperate and I believe it quite likely that many of the followers of Fincechiaro-Aprile, who is a losing popularity and the confidence of the people, will join with the Masi followers. Their platform has not
